Meet Joyce Van Horn, February's #1 ranked astrologer on Yelp.com. So what is it that makes Joyce one of the best astrologers in the country?

Joyce was born in 1952 in Burlingame, California. She was raised as a loose Baptist in the hippie era and can remember wanting to get her palm read as a child. At 17, Joyce took an interest in tarot cards when her father's secretary gave a deck to her family as a gift. Joyce was fascinated and started doing readings for her friends. She had a knack for it, but mainly did it for fun. When her friends started referring people to her she realized that there should be some kind of profit margin so she started charging. Soon enough, she understood

that astrology readings and life coaching could be a career so she looked at the most successful astrologers at that time and strived to be them. With a bit of self-marketing and an attitude that said, "I don't give a rip what anyone says", she became one of the most successful astrologers in the country.

The traditional view of astrologers is that each planet is the body and expression of a spiritual being or entity (i.e. [deva](#), [asura](#), [god](#), [goddess](#), [guide](#)). These spiritual beings are expressions of the soul, or life force. These planets affect and guide

the destinies of life forms on earth. The science behind it is still unproven, but recent advances in quantum physics suggest that the planetary alignments could very well have an affect on our daily lives.

Before Joyce meets you face to face, she takes down your time, date, and place of birth, and prints out an astrology chart of where the planets were positioned when you were born and where the planets are positioned now. She tells you what kind of moods you are in during this point of your journey and gives suggestions on

how to approach these moods. Then she applies this information to what's going on in your present life.

I find this very accurate because I started dating my girlfriend in July of 2011. She goes on to tell me about a mood of power, courage and conflict that possess me in my career life.

A mood that says, "I need to prove myself to myself". It is a path that requires inspiration, not motivation. She explains the difference,

"Motivation has implied in it, 'you should, you must, you have to'. When you're inspired it's really different, you feel like it."

These words gave me the goose bumps because that is exactly what I am going through right now. I was amazed by her
